HEALTH SERVICES—CENTRAL PROVINCE
AUTHORITIES STATUTE No. 06 OF 1990**

A STATUTE TO MAKE PROVISION FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DEPARTMENT
OF HEALTH SERVICES IN THE CENTRAL PROVINCE OF SRI LANKA IN RESPECT
(OF FUNCTIONS DEVOLVED AS SET OUT IN ITEM II (i, ii, iii, iv & v) OF
LIST No. 1 IN THE NINTH SCHEDULE OF THE 13th AMENDMENT TO THE
CONSTITUTION OF THE DEMOCRATIC SOCIALIST REPUBLIC OF SRI LANKA

BE IT PASSED BY THE PROVINCIAL COUNCIL OF THE CENTRAL PROVINCE of the
Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows :—

| 1. This statute may be cited as the Central Provincial Council (Devolution of the Powers of Supervision of the Administration of the Department of Health Services Statute) No. 06 of 1990 and shall come into operation on the date of receiving the assent of the Governor of the Province. | Short title and date of operation. |
| 2. There shall be a Department of Health Services and Medical Institutions, Divisional Health Officers and other Officers and Employees may be appointed from time to time. | Department of Health Services. |
| 3. There shall be an appointed person to be or to act as Director General of Health Services and Deputy Directors of Health Services and Assistant Directors of Health Services for specified aspects of Health. | Creation of Posts. |
| 4. Subject to the general direction and control of the Provincial Minister, the officers and employees of the Department shall execute and shall have power to enforce the provisions of this Statute and or of any regulations made thereunder. | Powers and Duties of officers. |
| 5. (1) The Provincial Minister may make regulations for the purpose of giving affect to the principles and provisions of this Statute. | |

- (2) In particular and without prejudice to the generality of the powers conferred by Sub section (i, ii, iii, iv & v) the Provincial Minister may make regulation in respect of all or any of the following purposes.
- (a) The establishment and maintenance of public Hospitals Rural Hospitals, Maternity Homes, Dispensaries, (other than Teaching Hospitals and Hospitals Established for special purposes);
 - (b) Public Health Service, Health Education, Nutrition, Family Health, Maternity and Child Care, Food & Food Sanitation, enviremental Health ;
 - (c) Formulation and implementation of Health Development Plan and of the Annual Health Plan for the Province ;
 - (d) The provisions of facilities for all institutions referred to in (a) above within the Province excluding the procurement of Drugs ;
 - (e) Awarding of scholarships for Post Graduate Education within Sri Lanka to personnel attached to the Institutions specified in (a) above ;
- (3) Every regulation made by the Minister under this statute shall be submitted to the Provincial Council for approval, and shall come into operation only on the approval of the Provincial Council.
6. In this Statute, unless the context otherwise requires " Minister " means the Minister in charge of the Subject of Health Services, of Central Province
" Director " means the Director of Health Services of Central Province.
