### FINANCIAL (AMENDMENT) STATUTE OF THE CENTRAL PROVINCE, No. 01 OF 1993

#### A STATUTE TO AMEND THE FINANCIAL STATUTE OF THE CENTRAL PROVINCE No. 17 OF 1990.

Be it passed by the Provincial Council of the Central Province as follows:

Short Title.

1. This Statute may be cited as the Financial (Amendment) Statute of the Central Province, No. 01 of 1993.

Amendment of long title of the Financial Statute of the Central Province No. 17 of 1990.

2. The long title of the Financial Statute of the Central Province No. 17 of 1990 is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "and the Stamp Duty Act, No. 43 of 1982 as amended." thereof and the insertion of the following words therefor:-

"the Stamp Duty Act, No. 43 of 1982 as amended, the Excise Ordinance, as amended, the Municipal Councils Ordinance, as amended, the Urban Councils Ordinance, as amended, and the Pradeshiya Sabhas Act, No. 15 of 1987."

Sinhala text to prevail in the event of an inconsistency.

3. In the event of an inconsistency between the Sinhala and Tamil texts of this Statute, the Sinhala text shall prevail.
